

**COUNCIL AS A WHOLE COMMITTEE MEETING

Mr. Morley: Mr. Slocum?

Mr. Slocum: As we covered in Committee last week we had this budgeted to be paid out of both the sewer and road fund this year. At the end of this year our radios that we currently have will not work. We have an opportunity to purchase radios right now in conjunction with the City of Mentor and the program compared to the State bid will save us \$7,000 - \$8,000. It is my full recommendation this legislation be adopted.

Mr. Morley: Mr. Klammer, as we discussed in Committee it is acceptable to do this?

Mr. Klammer: Yes.

Mayor Andrzejewski: We had to purchase these radios because of the new County telecommunications system.

Mr. Morley: We had grants for both the police and fire to cover some of the cost of the radios that we have already purchased.
