LEGISLATION PROPOSED:

<u>05-08-(01): AMENDMENT: ORDINANCE NO.: 2007-063, ADOPTED JUNE 12, 2007: TAX INCENTIVE PROGRAM</u>

Mr. Morley: Ms. Vaughn or Mr. Slocum?

Mr. Slocum: Basically what we are proposing is to have our incentives more in line with the surrounding cities. Currently the City is offering up to 100% rebate on taxes which in our estimation should be limited to 50% and we can adjust it by the number of years depending on the dollar amount they bring in. We strongly recommend Council's consideration.

Mr. Morley: Ms. Vaughn?

Ms. Vaughn: Mr. Slocum covered it admirably. I have nothing additional.

05-08-(02): TAX INCENTIVE GRANT: BEST SUPPLY, INC.

Mr. Morley: Ms. Vaughn?

Ms. Vaughn: I will defer to Mr. Slocum – he can discuss the tax incentive grant for Best Supply, Inc.

Mr. Slocum: Best Supply has relocated to Melinz Pkwy. in the City and started the relocation in October, 2010 and as we discussed in Committee the Administration recommends we grant them a five year tax incentive and a 50% rebate on the income taxes withheld.

5-08-(03): RESOLUTION: PROCLAIMING MAY, 2012: ARTHRITIS AWARENESS MONTH
