NEWS FROM (WRCDC)

If you live in Lake County and are 60 or older, you may be eligible for assistance with emergency home repairs or home modifications. The Western Reserve Community Development Corporation has received funding from the Lake County Senior Services Levy.

This program may assist with critical emergency repairs and accessibility modifications such as hand rails, grab bars, carpentry, electrical, heating systems, hot water tanks, plumbing issues and kitchen and bathroom accessibility modifications.
