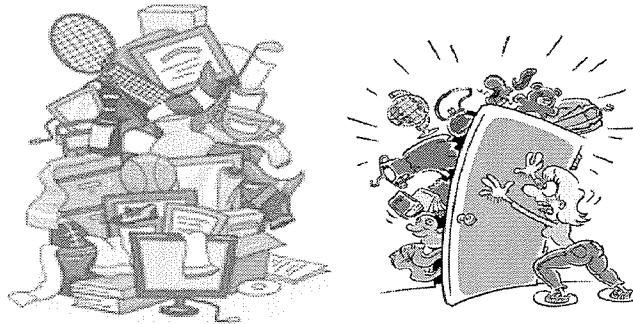
### BINGO

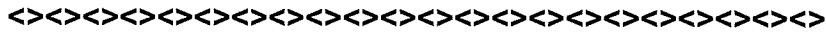
